The Thai Labour Market Situation in December 2021, Employers and establishments report their Labour requirement through the Department of Employment (DOE) that there are 27,361 job vacancies. It has decreased by 16.82% at the same time of last year. The insured persons (article 33) are 11,137,211 persons and insured person for unemployment benefits are 253,348 persons, have decreased by 35.86% at the same time of last year. The major cause of unemployment is resignation 68.89%.

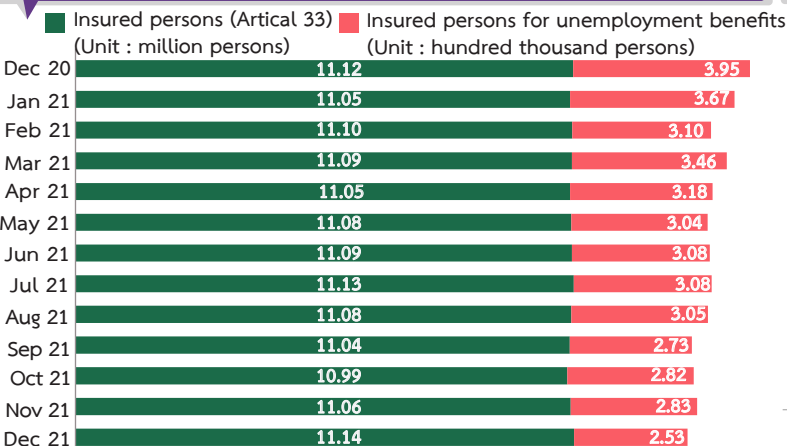

1. Unemployment Situation

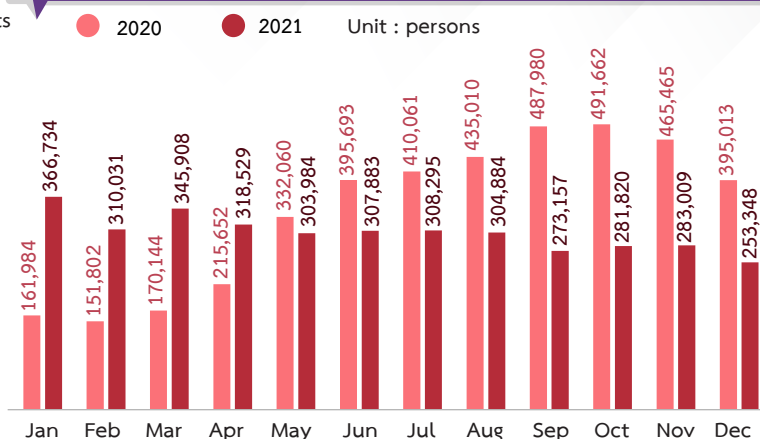


Social Security Office Statistic of December 2021 reports the number of insured persons (Article 33) are 11,137,211 persons and insured persons for unemployment benefits are 253,348 persons (2.27% of insured persons). Comparing to the same period last year, the insured persons for unemployment benefits decreased by 35.86% (141,665 persons). There are three types of unemployment, the highest is resignation 68.89%, followed by lay off 25.82% and end of the employment contract 5.29%.

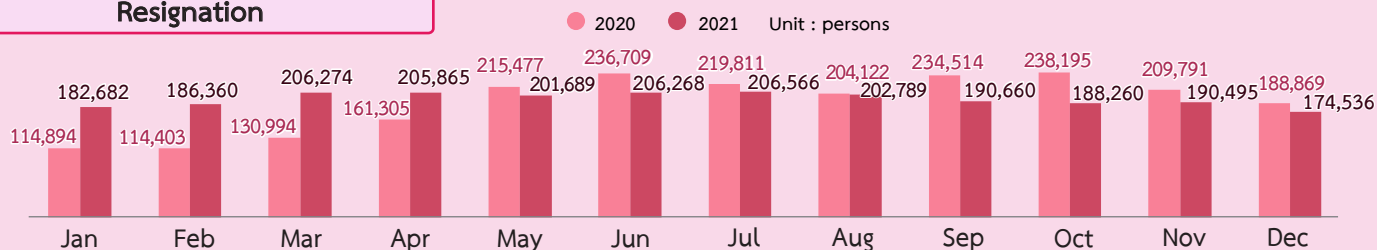

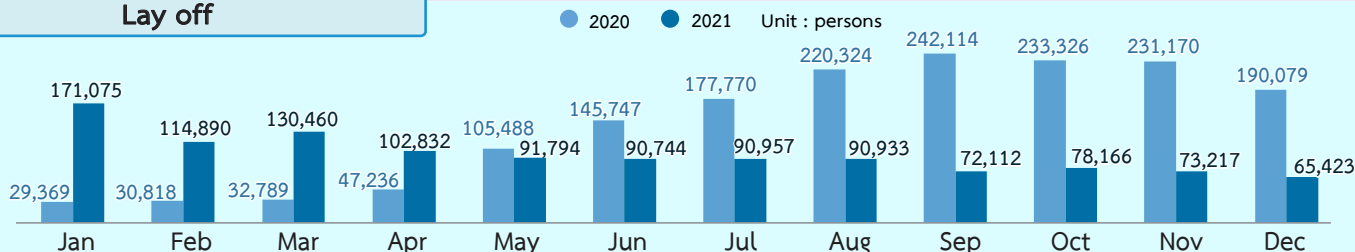

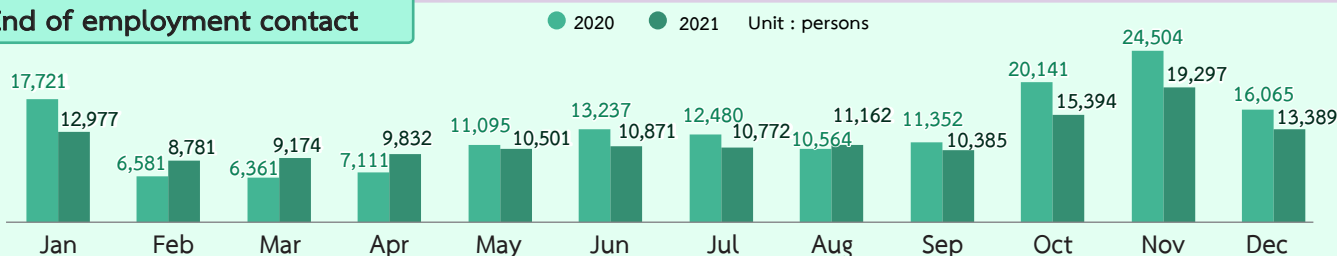

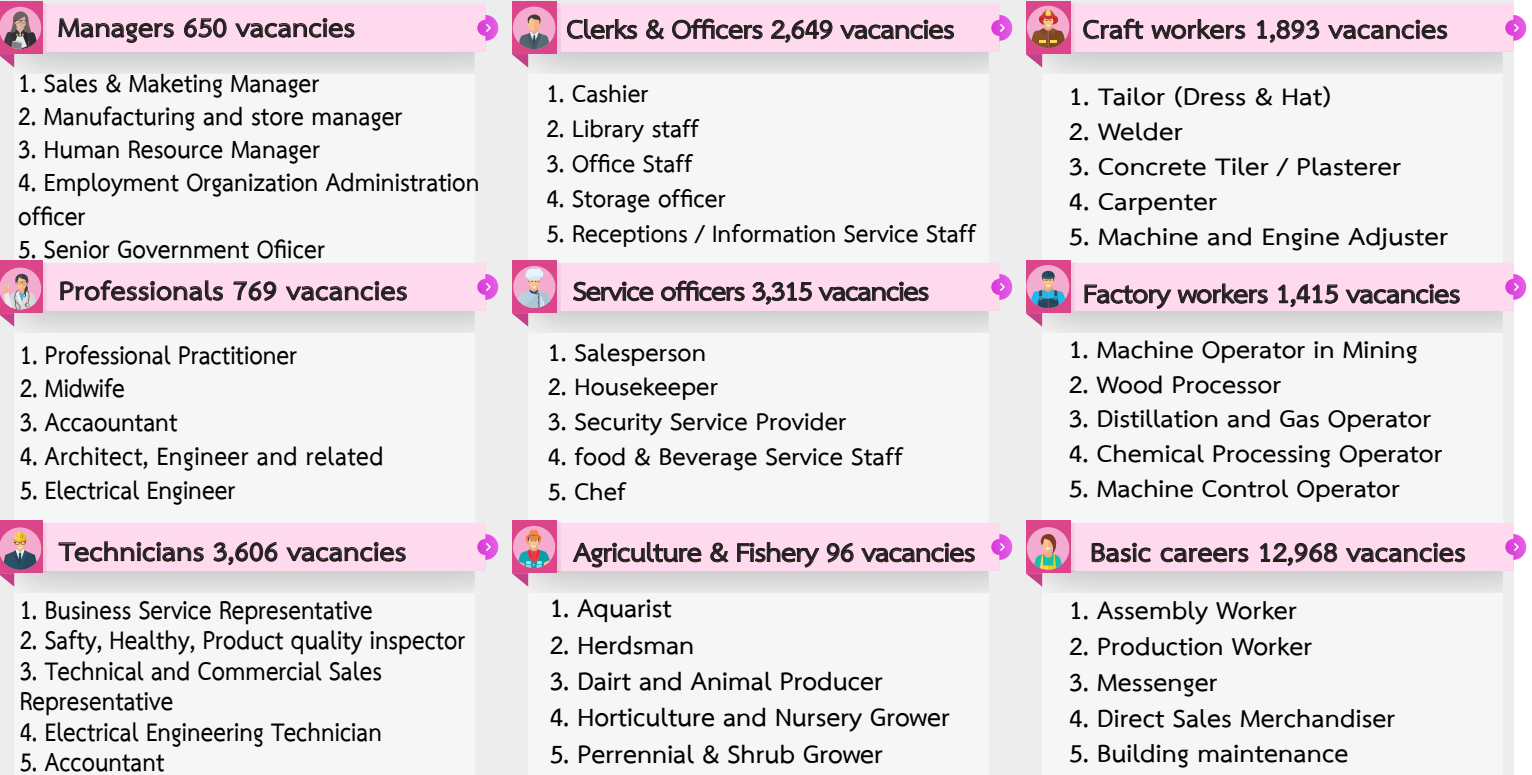
2. Labour Demand : Domestic Labour Demand (DOE)



In December 2021, there are 27,361 Job vacancies from 170 companies. The highest demand is 9,752 persons (35.64%) in secondary level, followed by 9,470 persons (34.61%) in vocational level, 5,002 persons (18.28%) in Primary level, 2,961 persons (10.82%) in Bachelor degree and the lowest demand is 176 persons (0.64%) in Post graduate level.

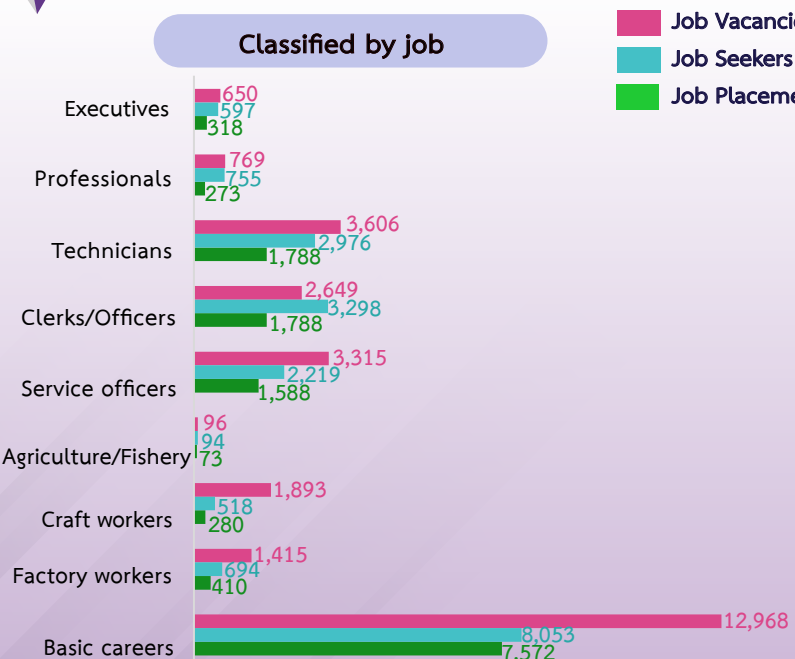


Top 5 job vacancies among occupation groups

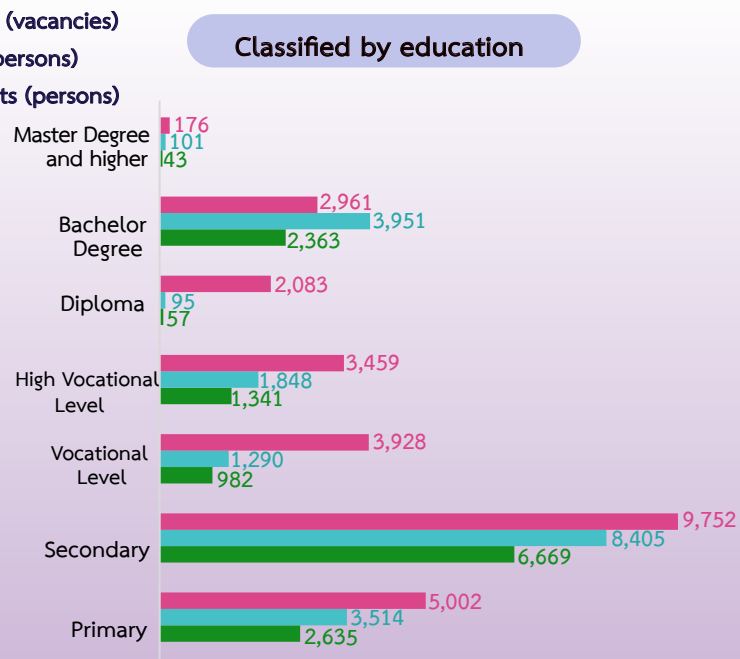


Job Vacancies, Job Seekers and Job Placements

Classified by education

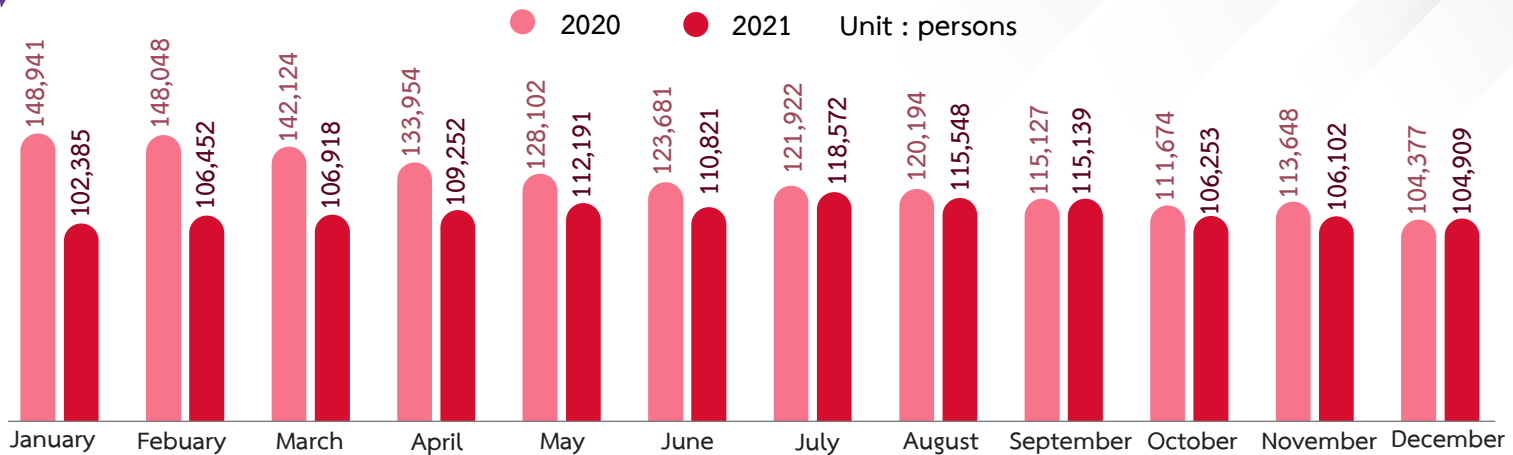

3. Labour Emigration : Thai workers working oversea

In December 2021, there are 104,909 Thai workers working oversea. The top 3 countries of destination are Taiwan, Israel and Republic of Korea. The most required jobs are Agricultural workers, general labourers and produces metal products labours.

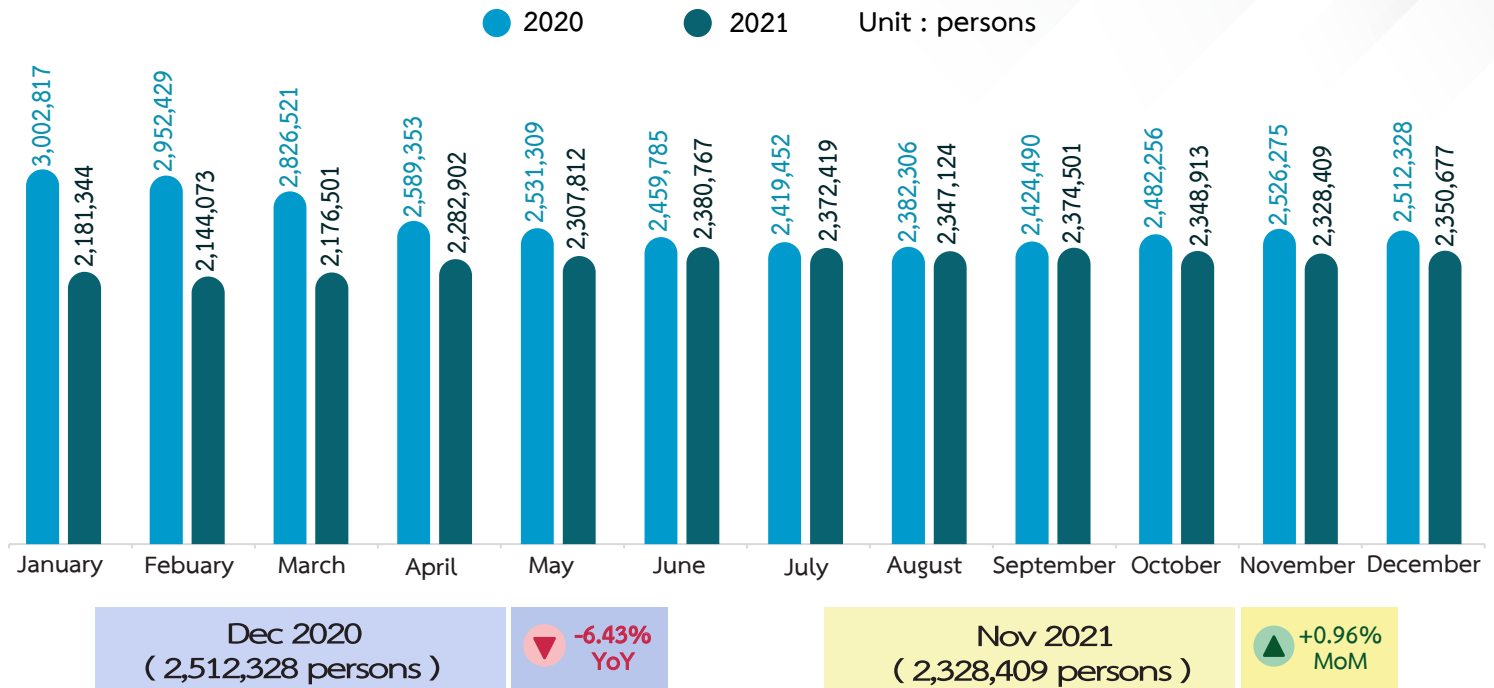

4. Labour Immigration : Foreign Workers

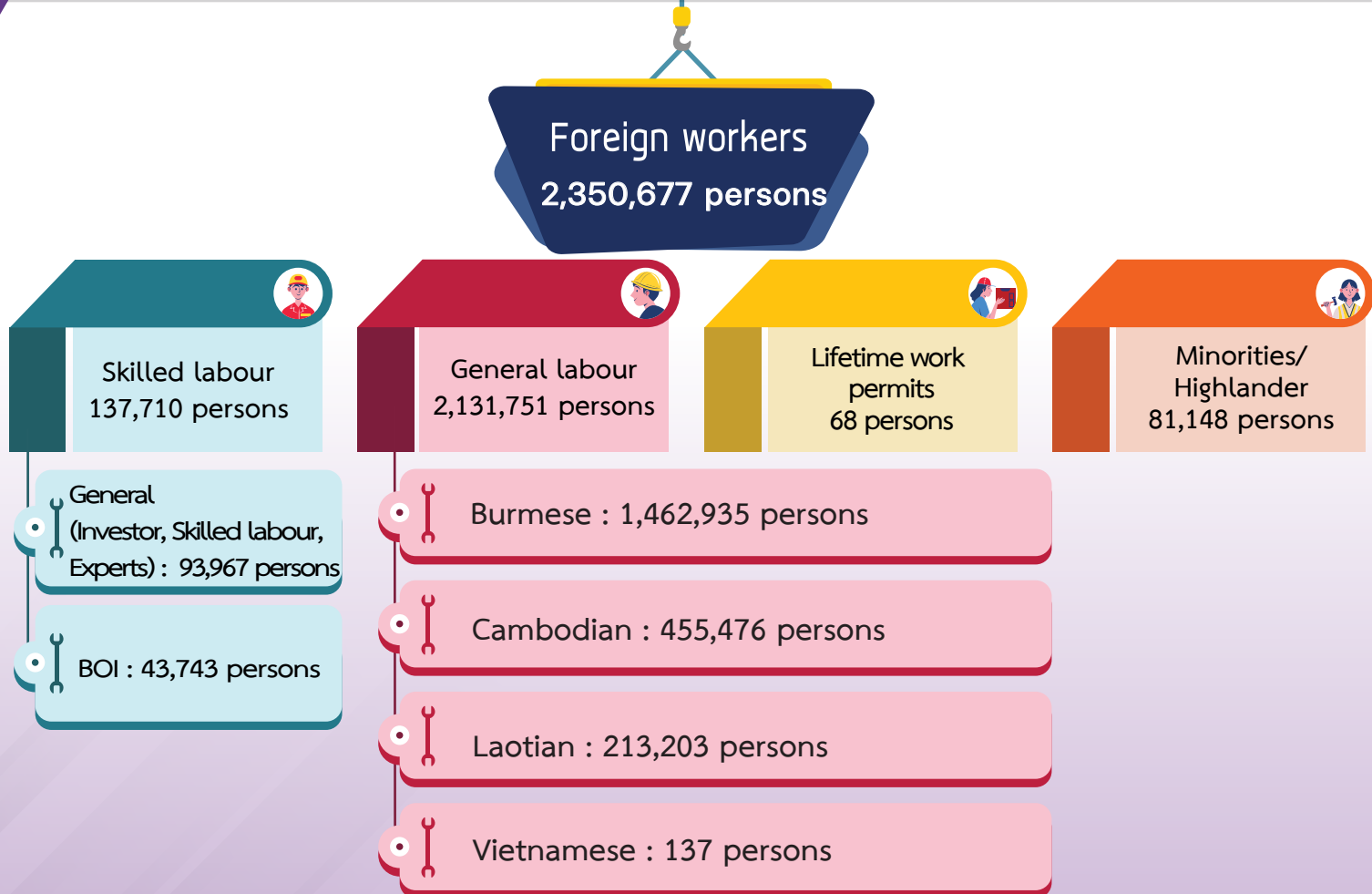


As of December 2021, there are 2,350,677 foreign workers in Thailand. General worker is the biggest group with 2,131,751 workers or 90.69%. Skilled foreign workers contributed to 137,710 workers or 5.86% and Minorities/ Highlander/Lifetime work permits 81,216 workers or 3.45%

Current foreign workers classified by group



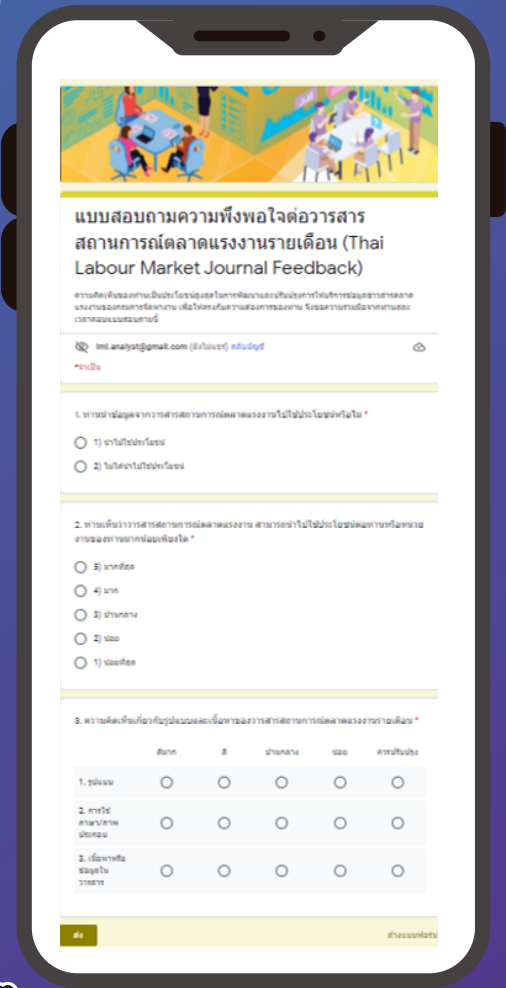
